



PERMIT PARKING SURVEY

Walmer Rd. North of Austin Terrace

As the first step in taking back our streets from the number of visitors to Casa Loma who use our streets as free parking during events at the castle, we are conducting a survey of homes on Walmer Rd. to determine what changes, if any, local residents want to the current regime for On Street Parking Permits. A proposal to change the permit parking times for Castlevue Ave. is currently in process. The proposed times for Castlevue are 12:01AM to 10AM and 6PM to 8PM. The alternatives below for Walmer Rd. were chosen through initial discussions with residents.

Current On Street Parking Permit Times	Walmer Rd.	2AM to 10AM
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OPTIONS

1

On Street Parking Permit required 24 hrs. a day 7 days a week

This option will preclude visitors to Casa Loma from using Walmer Rd. for parking at any time. It will mean an inconvenience to trades people and guests.

2

On Street Parking Permit required from 2 AM to 10 AM and 5 PM to 7 PM Monday to Friday and all day Saturday & Sunday

This option will give resident permit holders first access to open spaces between 5 PM to 7PM Monday to Friday and will reserve all spaces for permit holders on weekends. It will mean an inconvenience to guests between 5 PM and 7 PM Monday to Friday and weekends but not likely trades as most trades people work daytime Monday to Friday.

NO Change to existing On Street Parking Permit regulations.

We are working with the CITY to initiate a system of free Guest Passes which can be used by residents to accommodate visitors. This will be a process as it is not in use anywhere in the CITY today and our success is therefore uncertain.
