Dear Ms. Breitman:

This letter is to advise you that the City of Toronto, specifically Municipal Licensing and Standards Division, has been working with the Liberty Entertainment Group, City Legal and the local residents to mitigate the ongoing noise issues resulting from the outdoor summer performance season at Casa Loma.

I am pleased to report that the City of Toronto and the Liberty Entertainment Group have reached a mutual agreement that would apply to any further outdoor events incorporating amplified sound for the balance of this year, and going forward.

The City of Toronto will continue to work cooperatively with the Liberty Entertainment Group to communicate on any further issues that may arise, however, this will not result in any immunity from the City of Toronto laying and prosecution or charges in the future.

The details of the agreement are as follows:

- The Liberty Entertainment Group will not increase the current number of speakers at Casa Loma, which is four UPJunior-XP loudspeakers as front mains, three pairs of delayed UP-4XP loudspeakers and two UMS-1XP subwoofers.
- 2. These speakers will all have Meyer Sound's Intelligent DC technology. This sound system will have constant, live oversight by a sound technician who is employed by the Liberty Entertainment Group.
- 3. The sound technician will continuously walk the perimeter of the castle walls and adjust the sound system in accordance with the City's noise by-law. These adjustments will take into account factors such as wind direction, air temperature, humidity and levels of traffic noise.
- 4. The sound technician will record the noise levels, which can then be reviewed by Municipal Licensing and Standards staff.
- 5. The outdoor amplification of sound shall cease at 10:00 p.m.

I would like to thank you for the assistance you have provided to my staff and I over the summer. I am hopeful that the partnerships we have built will enhance the quality of life for the residents in the Casa Loma neighbourhood.
